

LOGOS SCHOOL SECOND SEMESTER ELECTIVES 2011-12

(*Indicates Fine Arts)

Annual – Mrs. Spencer (15 students) – Students will learn; digital photography, basics of page design, procurement of advertising. These skills will be used to produce the Logos Annual using the yearbook software online. The school has a limited number of computers for student use. It is preferable that they use their own personal laptop with wireless capability. There are a limited number of digital cameras owned by the school if a student does not have access to one.

***Calligraphy** – Mrs. Isenberg (12 students, \$5 materials fee) – Students will learn how to write in Italic, Gothic and Uncials.

***Chorus** – Dr. Erb – (*Required for 7th and 8th grade girls in the fall and 7th and 8th grade boys in the spring. Open to HS students as well.*) – We will be preparing a variety of musical pieces for several performance opportunities. We will also be building upon our knowledge of music theory and history as we seek to glorify God in all we sing.

Conditioning – Mr. Holloway (high school only, 20 students, possibly more) – This class focuses on improving the strength and quickness of our high school athletes. Class begins at 8:00 AM and uses a number of stations in the weight room and gym.

Latin Tutor – Mr. Sumpter – This elective is for new students who are beginning their Latin studies as well as more experienced students who need additional instruction and practice in order to be successful in their current Latin class.

King Alfred's English – Mrs. Courtney (25 students) – This elective class is designed for students in grades 7-12 with an Honors option for qualified students in grades 9-12. This course studies the history of the English language as well as linguistics, English literature, and the English Bible. This class will account for the changes in the English language from Old English through modern day with special focus upon Shakespeare and the writing of the King James Version of the Bible.

***Watercolor** – Mr. Garfield (16 students, \$25 materials fee) – This painting course will focus on watercolor (vs acrylic) techniques. Although it is not limited by age, it is limited to serious (vs apathetic) art students. The \$25 fee will go toward the purchase of decent watercolor paper, which students will keep when their paintings are complete.

Typing – Mrs. Polek (10 students) – This is a beginning typing course. It is highly recommended for junior high school students and others who cannot type.
