Parent Checklist for Admission:

- Application (pages 3-8, you may keep this page for your records)
- Upon acceptance, a non-refundable registration fee is due: K-12 \$200/student. Part-time, Preschool, and Logos Recitations \$50/student. If unable to pay, contact Tom Garfield, Superintendent at admin@logosschool.com
- ☐ Copies of standardized test scores and report cards from the past two years
- ☐ Copy of any divorce/custody decision as it pertains to the applicant
- Copy of updated immunization record or an exemption form (see the front office).
- ☐ All new elementary (1st—6th) students are required to take an entrance exam, \$20

International Students Only—In addition to the above items, please include:

- Scores documenting 70th percentile or higher on ELPT, TOEFL, or SLEP (English language proficiency tests).
- ☐ A one-time additional registration fee of \$800 (due upon acceptance)
- ☐ Proof of ability to pay tuition must be received before an I-20 can be issued (a copy of a bank statement is adequate)
- ☐ Tuition for the year must be prepaid within the first month of school starting
- ☐ Students who will be boarding with another family must be at least 15 years old.

Part-Time Classes

Registration: This is a one-time payment each year and should be turned in with the student application (for full-time K-12 students \$100 of the annual registration fee will be credited to the last tuition payment). This fee is non-refundable at any time, unless acceptance is denied. Registration will be finalized only when the entire registration fee is paid, or other arrangements are made with the superintendent.

Tuition: Monthly tuition payments are due by the fifth working day of each month. Typically these payments are divided over twelve months, July through June. Families may opt to pay higher per-month payments over a shorter period, such as nine or ten months. Payments may be mailed, dropped off, or automatically deposited.

- -Full-year pre-payment discount: A 5% discount will be applied to tuition which is paid by July 9th.
- -Full-time ministry discount: 10% (Call to determine if applicable.)
- -Alumni discount: 25% off each child in K-2, plus other discounts as applicable.




