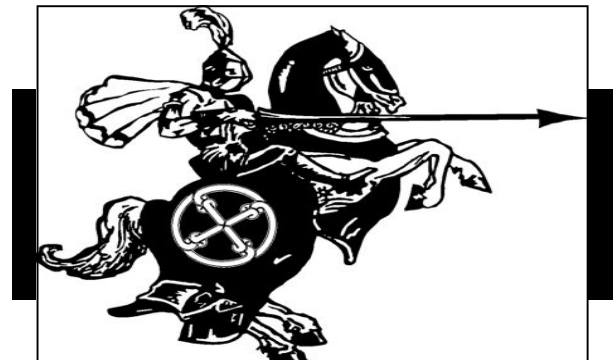

### Football Camp (ages 5-9) \$30

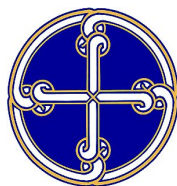
June 17-18, 10 am - 12 pm, Mr. Holloway & Mr. Isker
