

Logos School Reduced Tuition Plan (RTP) - 2023-24

Description: RTP was established by Logos to support families who wish to provide their children with a Christian education, but need financial assistance to do so. Since opening our doors in 1981, Logos School has not turned away one family unable to afford the entire tuition. Regarding any tuition concerns.... please don't let a possible financial burden keep you from applying. We seek to strengthen families, not profit margins.

Policy and Procedure:

1. The Scholarship is need-based (i.e. financial need) rather than merit (i.e. grades).
2. Awards are made yearly; a new application must be submitted every year. However, RTP may be modified mid-year if circumstances change.
3. Families seeking reduced tuition must:
 - A. Apply by April 15th (or, if admitted after April 15th, within 2 weeks)
 - B. Go through a 3rd party financial need verification process with [FACTS](#) (online)
 - C. Fill out a Logos RTP application (see below).
 - D. Participate in our Volunteer Program.
 - a. All family members may participate.
 - b. Participants log their hours in FACTS.
